Minister Mokonyane unharmed in Burglary at Mthatha Hotel

19 March 2017

The Minister of Water and Sanitation, Nomvula Mokonyane, was in the early hours of this morning a victim of burglary at an Mthatha Hotel. The Minister was in Mthatha attending the wedding ceremony of a relative and had on Friday delivered an OR Tambo Memorial Lecture at Walter Sisulu University.

Indications are that the intruders forcefully opened a window leading into the Minister's room, in which she was sleeping at the time. A handbag, cell-phones and tablet were among the items stolen. The Minister was unharmed.

A case of burglary and theft has been opened with the Mthatha Central Police Station and the matter is now under investigation.
