Upgrades could see Jacobsdal out of water restrictions

09 November 2017

Upgrades to a raw water supply station in Jacobsdal could see water restrictions being lifted. Work is currently underway of construction of a 5 mega litre storage reservoir, rehabilitation and lining of raw water storage dam and upgrade to a 70 litre per second pump set. Together with this work the existing clear water pump station will also be refurbished.

The project has created twenty one jobs and will impact 2 115 households. The estimated cost of the project R78,6 Million. The construction of the 5 mega litre clear water storage reservoir is 98% complete and the raw water pump station is sitting at 49%.

The refurbishment should see the town of Jacobsdal receiving optimal water and water restrictions rescinded. Water and Sanitation is constantly working tirelessly in partnership with municipalities to see communities receive basic services. Working together we can do more.
