DWS to consult stakeholders in the water sector on Raw Water Tariffs

09 July 2018

The KwaZulu-Natal Department of Water and Sanitation (KZN DWS) will host the Raw Water Tariff Consultation Session on Tuesday 10 July 2018 at 10h00 at eThekweni Training Centre in Durban. The aim of this session is to inform stakeholders about proposed raw water use charges for the 2018/2019 financial year.

The main aim of Raw Water Tariff Consultations is to explain the raw water use process to stakeholders. The department is mandated to consult with stakeholders and solicit their inputs on raw water tariff pricing in order to allow a process of budget planning and tariff determinations annually.

During the month of July, the KZN DWS — through the Pongola-Umzimkulu Proto Catchment Management Agency — will also be hosting sessions at Mooi River, Ixopo, Ladysmith, Newcastle, Richards Bay and Pongola. The consultation sessions will be used as a platform for stakeholders to give comments or make inputs regarding the proposed tariffs.
