Training Workshop for Councilors to improve quality of services on water and sanitation

29 January 2018

The KwaZulu-Natal Department of Water and Sanitation will host water and sanitation training workshop for provincial councilors on Wednesday 31 January 2018 at SALGA Offices in Musgrave, Durban at 09:00 am.

The aim of the workshop is to equip councillors with tools and knowledge in order to appropriately perform water and sanitation functions within municipalities. The workshop will also consult Water Services Authorities (WSAs) on the National Water and Sanitation Master Plan and further discuss the municipal bulk water supply debts.

The workshop forms part of developing capacity to Local Government officials to effectively perform their functions on water and sanitation and to improve the quality of services provided to communities in the Province. The workshop is targeting councilors chairing Water and Sanitation committees and officials responsible for the provision of Water Services within municipalities.

The Department will host the workshop in partnership with South African Local Government Association (SALGA) and Department of Cooperative Governance in KwaZulu-Natal (COGTA KZN).
