Department of Water and Sanitation to host a workshop on Water Services Development Planning

28 August 2019

The Department of Water and Sanitation in KwaZulu-Natal will host a workshop on Water Services Development Planning (WSDP) on Friday, 30 August 2019 at eThekweni Municipality Electricity Training Centre in Durban at 09:00 am.

The objective of the workshop is to give water sector stakeholders a detailed view of the WSDP and all the components that play a role in the planning for water services. The WSDP is a management support tool designed to ensure planning that is structured, factual and follows a knowledge system that incorporates all water and sanitation service provisions. It is meant to enhance the understating of the Water and Sanitation Business.

The Department must monitor the performance of every water services authority to ensure its compliance with every applicable water services development plan. The workshop will guide the stakeholders with the planning for the development of water services.

The workshop will gather stakeholders from water entities, local government, agriculture, industry and mining sectors, among others.

Stakeholders will use the WSDP to support its water services strategic planning process while the DWS will use the WSDP to regulate WSA compliance with respect to the water services planning processes as defined in Water Services Act.
