Weekly Status of Water Reservoirs in the Northern Cape

14 February 2019

While the Northern Cape received good rainfall over the past week, it is still not out of the woods. Residents are urged to continue using water sparingly.

The Full Water Supply Capacity in the Northern Cape is at 68% up from 67% last week. Water in storage is at 100.2%.

The Vaal River is at 75% and the Orange River at 66.2%.

The dam level at Spitskop on the Harts River is at 37.7%.

Douglas storage weir is at 107.3%,

Vaalharts storage weir is at 83.2%,

Boegoeberg 89.8% and the Karee Dam 31.2%.

The department is closely monitoring groundwater levels through its groundwater monitoring programme, as this source is very critical as well.
