# Background setting

# Overall objective

The goal of **development cooperation** will be to reduce poverty and inequality, in line with the government's policies and targets.

# Focal areas

- **Employment Creation**, with the emphasis on the second economy, fostering the links between the second and the first economies, generating employment, reducing inequality, developing skills and addressing social exclusion.
- **Capacity Development for Service Delivery and Social Cohesion**: Priority will be to improve capacity for service delivery by addressing bottlenecks in human and systems development

# Non-focal areas

- **Governance**. In the public domain the focus will be on fighting crime, including corruption, and promoting safety, security, the rule of law and the consolidation of democracy. There will be a parallel focus on human rights, mainly through the strengthening of civil society, including NGOs and social partners
- **Regional and Pan-African Support**. The aim of these initiatives is the alleviation of poverty by focusing on further regional integration
- **TDCA Facilities**. As part of the overall goal of enhancing the partnership between the EU and South Africa, the objective here is to fully implement the TDCA provisions on political dialogue, trade and investment issues, economic cooperation and development cooperation

**Indicative allocation of €980 million**

- Employment Creation. 35 - 45 %
  - Capacity Development for Service Delivery and Social Cohesion. 30 – 40 %
  - Governance. 5 - 20 %
  - Regional and pan-African support. 4 - 10%
  - TDCA Facilities. Up to 5%
